

**ABPP AWARD
ARTICLES, THESES, AND DISSERTATIONS (2026)**

The Brazilian Association of Political Psychology (ABPP), through its National Board, in partnership with the Political Psychology Journal (RPP), announces the OPENING OF REGISTRATION for the Award for unpublished Scientific Articles derived from doctoral theses and master's dissertations in the field of Political Psychology studies.

The objective is to promote the dissemination and recognition of scientific production in Political Psychology developed in Brazil and other countries in Latin America and the Caribbean.

The RPP will publish all the selected articles. They must therefore strictly comply with its scope, editorial policy, and current submission rules, available at: Revista Psicologia Política - Home Page.

Art. 1 – Purpose

The purpose of this call for papers is to award prizes to unpublished scientific articles derived from master's dissertations and doctoral theses in the field of Political Psychology.

Art. 2 – Target Audience

The following may apply:

- I – Individuals with master's and doctoral degrees in Psychology or related fields;
- II – Individuals who defended their dissertation or thesis between January 1, 2024, and December 31, 2025;
- III – Individuals enrolled in *stricto sensu* graduate programs in Brazil or other countries in Latin America and the Caribbean.

Art. 3. Categories

The contest is organized into the following categories:

- A) Articles from dissertations and theses defended in graduate programs in Psychology and related fields in Brazil;
- B) Articles from dissertations and theses defended in graduate programs in Psychology and related areas in other countries in Latin America and the Caribbean.

Art. 4 – Awards

The following awards will be given:

- 02 (two) Master's articles and 02 (two) Doctoral articles – Brazil;
- 02 (two) Master's articles and 02 (two) Doctoral articles – Latin America and the Caribbean.

The awards will consist of:

I – Publication of the article in the Political Psychology Journal;

II – Certificate for the authors, advisors, and the Graduate Program;

III – Institutional dissemination through the ABPP's official channels.

§1 Additional works that stand out in the evaluation may be mentioned in an editorial in the dossier and on the ABPP website, with a certificate issued, and being invited to contribute to future issues of the journal.

Art. 5. Documentation

Registrations must include:

- Registration form attached to this notice;
- Unpublished article derived from the thesis or dissertation, written in Portuguese, Spanish, or English, formatted according to the standards of the Revista Psicologia Política;
- Letter from the advisor, who must be listed as co-author, declaring knowledge of the submission and authenticity of the article's origin;
- Document proving the defense (diploma, minutes, or certificate);
- Proof of membership in the ABPP for all authors of the article with current annual dues (scanned). For more information on membership, visit the website: <https://psicologiaepolitica.org.br/>

Art. 6. Registration

All required documentation must be sent in a single file (PDF) to the email: concursoabpp@gmail.com

Art. 7. Approval of registrations

The Evaluation Committee will review the documentation and publish the list of approved registrations on the official ABPP channels.

§1 Registrations will not be approved if:

- Articles that are not derived from theses or dissertations;
- Articles that are not derived from theses or dissertations in the period indicated above;
- Works that do not adhere to the focus and scope of the Political Psychology Journal;
- Texts already published or submitted to other journals or books;
- Submissions outside the registration period or with incomplete documentation.

Art. 8 – Evaluation

Articles will be evaluated by the Evaluation Committee, in conjunction with the Editorial Team of the Political Psychology Journal, considering:

- I – Scientific and social relevance;
- II – Originality;
- III – Theoretical and methodological consistency;
- IV – Quality of academic writing;
- V – Contribution to the field of Political Psychology.

Art. 9. Results

The results will be announced on the ABPP social media channels starting on August 7, 2026.

Publication will be subject to:

- Compliance with editorial deadlines for review and adjustments;
- Compliance with the requirements of this call for papers.

When submitting to *the Revista Psicologia Política journal*, authors must indicate the following in the "Comments to the Editor" field: "Work derived from thesis/dissertation – ABPP Award 2026."

Announcement of approved submissions	June 7, 2026
Evaluation of entries	June 8 to July 31, 2026
Announcement of winning entries	Starting August 7, 2026
Submission to the journal via PEPSIC	August 21, 2026
Expected publication date	December 2026

Cases not covered in this notice will be resolved by the Evaluation Committee, whose decisions are final and binding.
